

## STEP 1 REACH OUT

#### STEP 2

#### **LET US LEARN MORE**

During the meeting, a Counseling Coordinator will ask about your student's goals, background, and preferences. For this reason, we recommend that the student participate in this meeting. This information helps our team determine if your student is a candidate for our services and which, if any, of our programs will meet your family's needs.

The Counseling Coordinator can also describe our philosophy, explain available options, and answer questions about our services.

#### STEP 3

### **MEET YOUR COUNSELOR**

(PINNACLE PROGRAM)

Families that are interested in the Pinnacle Program will meet with a counselor, who can explain his or her background and approach. The counselor will also ask questions to understand your family's expectations and needs. The nature of the college admissions process requires that the student and counselor are a good match, and both parties can assess this during the meeting.

## STEP 4 GET STARTED
