Live Online Orientation

We strongly encourage enrolled students and their parents to attend an orientation. The orientation explains our recommendations for testing and how to get the most out of your KD activities. For your convenience, all orientations will be live online sessions. Once you have registered and paid, you will receive instructions for attending the live online orientation. Our orientations are conducted by grade level so that we may give you the most targeted advice specific to your current place in the college admissions journey.

Initial Diagnostic Testing

New students can choose from the following options:

1. Take the Diagnostic Test at home or on campus during a scheduled testing time. This option is ideal for students who have not taken any national tests or who would like to get an updated score.
 - a. The test takes approximately 3 hours. You may pick up a copy of the test at one of our campuses or call one of our campuses to schedule a testing date. We believe the best way to test is taking a “paper / pencil” printed exam, just as you will on the national test day.
2. Submit recent national test scores (PSAT/NMSQT®, SAT®, or ACT® scores).

Registration and payment must be received at least 24 hours before orientation so that we can deliver meeting links and materials to you.
