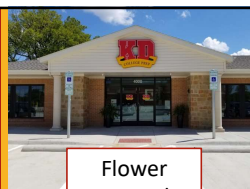

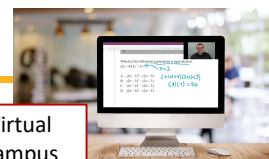

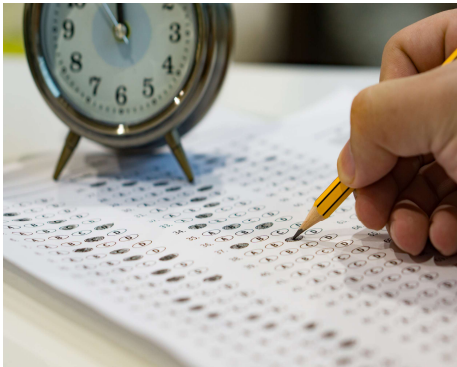

DFW Area Students

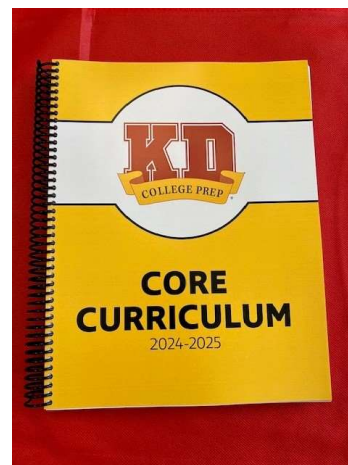
Pick up curriculum at least 3 days before your 1st class during business hours

Students Outside DFW Area

Curriculum will be shipped. An email will be sent with tracking information once the mailing label is created.



CORE LESSONS (14 Classes)

- **Proven curriculum** teaching content and strategy
- Some content is **above grade level**, so immediate mastery should not be expected
- **In-person or live online** instruction, or a combination of the two

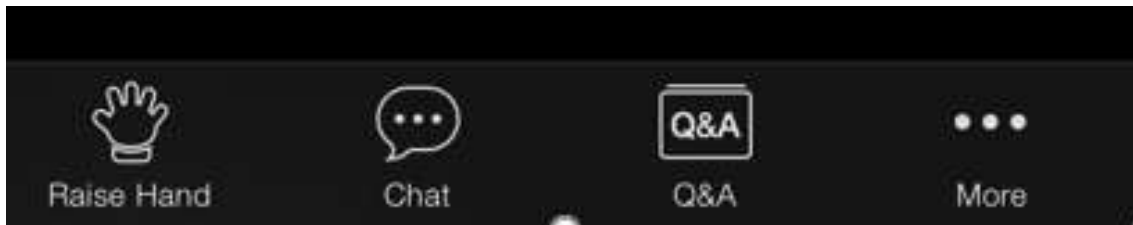

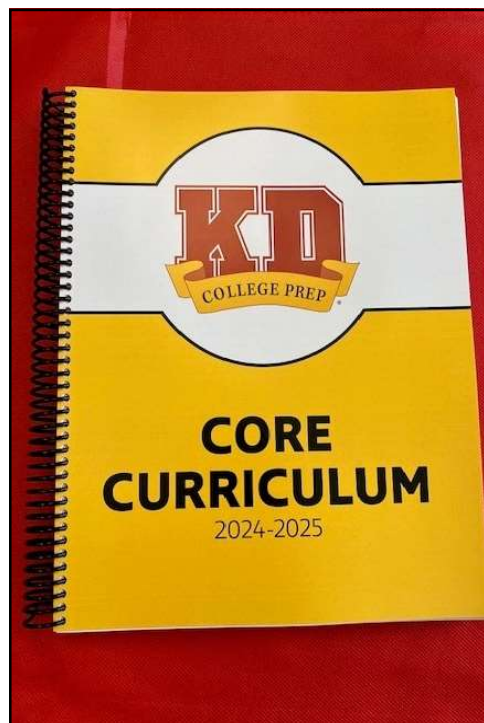

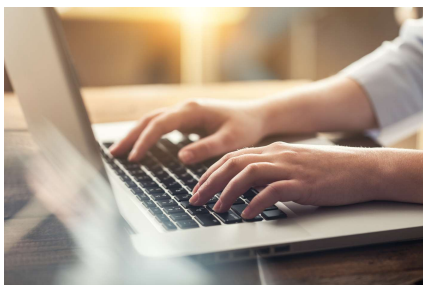
