



- National Merit® recognition can:

- Predicts your SAT® score
- Verbal Score 160-760
 <u>Math Score</u> 160-760

Note: The PSAT test in 9th and 10th grades are practice for the 11th grade PSAT/NMSQT® test

HOW TO BECOME A NATIONAL MERIT® SEMIFINALIST

Take the PSAT/NMSQT® test in October of 11th grade

Get scores back in December of 11th grade

Semifinalists are announced in September of 12th grade (Sept. 2025)

Meet Qualifying Selection Index Score (SIS)

- Must score higher than 99.5% of students in state
- TX Class of 2024 qualifying score 219/228
- Qualifying score can change every year

Class of	Cutoff
2024	219
2023	219
2022	220
2021	219
2020	221

To calculate SIS: (Verbal + Verbal + Math) / 10 = SIS(760 + 760 + 760) / 10 = max score 228

Examples of Scholarships for National Merit Finalists

- Texas Tech University Tuition, housing, meals, books, and \$4,400/yr. stipend
- University of Alabama Tuition, housing, books, \$3,500/yr. stipend, \$2,000 allowance for study abroad
- University of Oklahoma Most of tuition, \$5,500/yr.; \$121,500 value for nonresidents
- Oklahoma State University Tuition, \$5,500/yr., plus other stipends; \$145,400 value for non-residents)
- Boston University \$25,000/yr.
- Emory University \$2,000/yr.



- Check spam folder; email or call us if you don't receive it


Software



WHEN DO I ATTEND WORKSHOPS?



PRACTICE TESTS WITH PERSONALIZED REVIEWS

- Full-length digital PSAT formatted practice tests
- These tests are taken in June, July, August, September <u>and</u> October (One each month)
- Each test is followed with an OnDemand Test Review <u>and</u> a 1x1
 Personalized session with an instructor
- Each test must be fully reviewed before taking another test
- Take and review at least 5 tests (post-lesson Diagnostic Test (DT2) and 4 PSAT formatted tests) before the October 2024 PSAT test

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS



Start the program between May 22 and June 25 and continue until the October test



Attend all 14 lessons including the diagnostic test and review.



Attend at least 10 **Workshops (20 hours)** between June and the October 2024 PSAT test date. (2 workshops each month)



Complete 4 additional full-length **PSAT/NMSQT*** formatted practice tests and attend the personalized reviews for a total of 5 tests. You must not have any testing irregularities. There must be at least 2 days between practice tests. (at least 1 test each month)



Register and take the PSAT/NMSQT® test in October 2024.



Students must be enrolled in your current school district for the 2024-2025 school year in order to participate.




